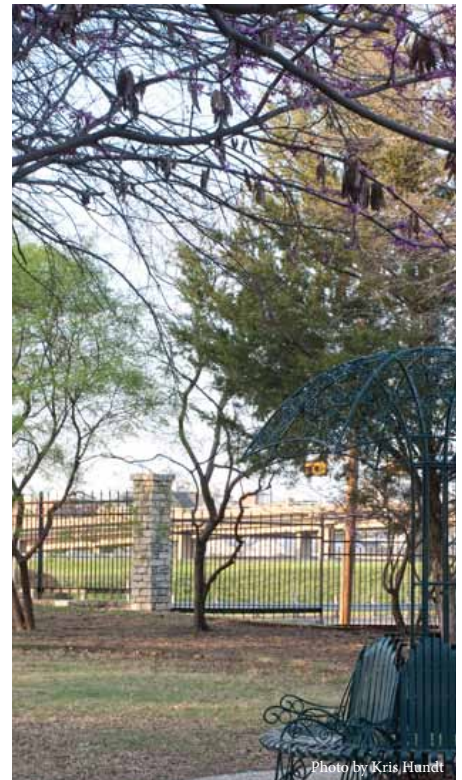

The Pavillion

The Pavillion is an open air structure with doors that slide open and pop out, allowing for an almost completely open air event. It is surrounded by the beauty of our manicured lawns and outdoor charm, with a backdrop of our 38-historic structures.

The Pavillion provides 4,000 square feet of banquet or reception space. By tenting the surrounding green space with our 40x60 tent, we can add another 2,400 square feet and seating for another 200 people (see tent pricing). Please inquire about customized packages starting as a low as \$2,500.00

Renner School House

The perfect alternative to the conference room, Renner School is completely climate controlled, has numerous electrical outlets and can be set up auditorium style or with tables for workspace. The large open structure of our second floor allows easy setup for presentations, lectures or discussion groups and can accommodate groups as large as 100.

The Renner School is also now available on Sundays (subject to availability due to museum programs) for baby and bridal showers. For \$12 per person (party minimum of 25), you can have access to the school and guests get admission to the museum and free parking. Lunch and refreshments are extra and are available through our list of approved caterers. Your lunch can be fully catered or just prepared for drop off.

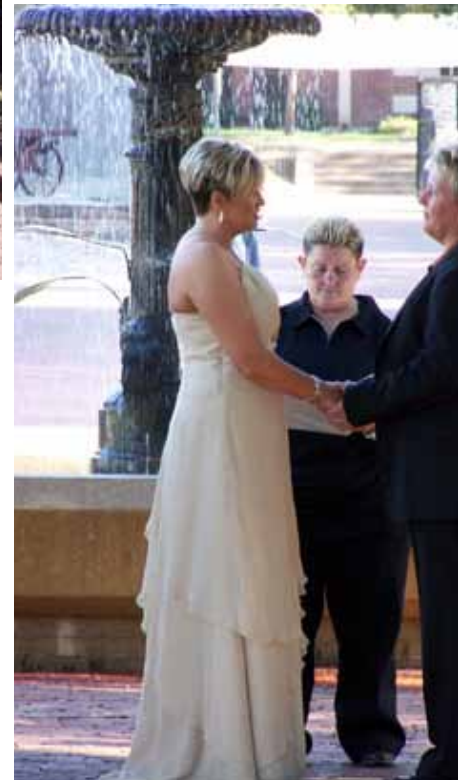

Wedding Photography

One benefit of having your wedding at Dallas Heritage Village is the opportunity for exterior photos on the grounds. Additionally, you can take interior photos in your rented facility. As a rental package benefit, you are allowed to set-up a separate photography time at the museum for an engagement or bridal portrait. You provide your own photographer. During this separate time, you have access to the Bridal Suite (certain times before 4pm) for hair and make-up if needed. If you have not booked your wedding at Dallas Heritage Village, you can still have bridal portraits or engagement photos taken at Dallas Heritage Village.

- 2 hours photography on the Grounds: \$150
- With the use of the Bridal Suite for make-up: \$275

Build your own package

Looking to do a truly Texas-Style rehearsal dinner? If you are looking for a more casual and rustic event, you can “build a package” of any size or type—from a small party in The Main Street Saloon to a larger dinner in the Renner School or around The Main Street Fountain. You can even hire our ragtime piano player or have a band play outside on the Main Street Stage. Pick up your guests at the front gate with our fringed-top surrey in true Texas-Style, or rent Nip and Tuck, our Mammoth Jack Donkeys, and offer wagon rides around the Village, complete with a history lesson, for your guests. The combinations are endless!



With our standard Corporate Picnic Package price of \$13 per person (200 person minimum), you and your guests will enjoy up to 6-hours of non-stop fun! Package price includes a private rental of the Pavilion and green space beside it (Saturdays not available), up to 20-60” round tables (linens not included), and up to 10-8’ banquet tables for the outside greenspace. Also included is admission to the Museum, an event liaison and free parking.

Up to 200 white plastic chairs may be rented at \$1.00 per chair with no set-up fee. We do not allow self-catering at the museum and above price does not include food and beverage. Tents are available at an additional charge.

Portrait and Bridal Photography

Portrait photographers are welcome at Dallas Heritage Village! Our blooming florals, trees and valleys make the perfect setting for portrait photography.

Photographers can shoot portrait photography FREE if the following requirements are met:

- Photographer is a Family Scout (or higher level) member of Dallas Heritage Village. [Click here to join today!](#)
- You must shoot during regular operating hours of Tuesday-Saturday, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. or Sunday, Noon – 4 p.m. Shooting on Mondays or during January and August when we are closed will require contacting the Director of Sales to schedule and pricing will then be at the commercial rate.
- Photographer's clients are required to pay regular admission prices of \$9 adult, \$7 seniors and \$5 children.
- No dressing areas are included. If dressing or staging areas are needed, these will be charged at rental pricing of \$150 for suites and/or required spaces.
- No interior photography is allowed with this package. If interior photography is requested, you will be charged at the commercial photography rates. Scheduling is required through the Director of Sales and is contingent upon the permission of the Curator. The Curator must be present for any interior photography at the rate of \$25/hour.
- For non-members, portrait and bridal photography rates are \$100/ho

Commercial Photography, Video and Film

Dallas Heritage Village is the perfect setting for your next commercial project! With the City of Dallas as your background and the theme of historic Texas as your paint brush, there are many creative options for your next photography or print project.

The museum grounds and buildings are available in a limited capacity for commercial photography, video and film production. Photography and film shoots that are booked at the full day rate include a green room and parking for RV, and tables and chairs for craft services. A breakdown of the types of rental photography that we allow is contained on this page. Commercial Photography

Dallas Heritage Village is a favorite destination for commercial photographers and advertising agencies. Our landscape architecture and historic buildings are the perfect backdrop for product and catalog shoots. Because the museum is closed to the public on Mondays, it's a perfect day for the trade to come in and take advantage of our beautiful setting.

Commercial Photography Rates

Dallas Heritage Village has reasonable rates and minimums for commercial photographers. We offer hourly rates, ½ day rates and full day rates with use of the Park Cities Heritage House for green room space. The parking lot in front of the Park Cities Heritage House is perfect for RVs and mobile crew parking. To contract a photo shoot, contact the Director of Sales.

1/2 day rate: \$650 (5 hours)

Video & Film

Dallas Heritage Village has been featured in numerous TV commercials, videos and films. In the past few years, our grounds have been used to shoot several episodes of Walker, Texas Ranger; The Good Guys and various documentaries. Video and film production require advanced planning so that we can meet the needs of your production team while remaining open to the public. Exterior Photography

Dallas Heritage Village allows for exterior photography only. Tourists and guests of the museum are able to shoot candid photos during their visit. Professional photographers with digital cameras, tripods and other commercial equipment are required to book a shoot and sign applicable releases. Dallas Heritage Village only contracts commercial shoots for one time use. The work that results from the shoot cannot be a product that is resold for the benefit of the client. Interior photography is usually not permitted, as flash can damage certain artifacts and wallpapers. The only exception to this policy can be made through the museum's Curator. Catering

Dallas Heritage Village has worked hard to elevate the quality and quantity of caterers available to our clients for rentals. We have learned through experience that it is to everyone's benefit to use those caterers that we have an active relationship with, thus ensuring our clients receive both the best service and food available. Additionally, these caterers are familiar with working here at the Village and know what we expect from them as well. We, therefore, ask that you only use a caterer that has been approved by Dallas Heritage Village. Approved caterers are selected for the quality of their services, their ability to meet legal, TABC and insurance requirements, their commitment to following museum catering guidelines, and the ability to serve customers in all budget ranges. The Village routinely monitors, updates and alters the list of approved caterers in an attempt to create a comprehensive list of caterers that will be appropriate for every event. If you choose to go off of our approved catering list, there is an additional charge of \$500.00.

Dallas Heritage Village requires you to provide the Director of Sales with a copy of your food and beverage invoice for audit purposes. If a substitute caterer is used, that caterer must satisfy all of our requirements of the approved caterer's program. You are required to notify the Director of Sales at least 45 days in advance that you are using a substitute caterer. The Village retains the right to refuse a substitute for any reason.

Dallas Heritage Village does not allow self-catering or partial self-catering under any circumstances. All food delivered to Dallas Heritage Village must be prepared in advance in a licensed kitchen. Use of BBQ grills with charcoal starter or deep fryers is strictly prohibited.

Alcohol

You are permitted to have alcoholic beverages at your event. Dallas Heritage Village, however, does not have a liquor license and cannot take possession of or store alcohol in any form under any circumstances. You are responsible for complying with all applicable state and federal laws pertaining to the serving of alcoholic beverages and for ensuring that your service provider complies with these laws as well. Dallas Heritage Village requires only TABC certified bartenders distribute alcoholic beverages, and we are not responsible for any damages resulting from any failure to obtain these permits.

There is an additional \$250.00 Mixed Beverage Fee for anything other than beer, wine and champagne, and additional liability waivers might be required. This includes Margarita machines or frozen drink machines.

Since many of our caterers do not have a full liquor license, we require the renter to use a company that does have a full liquor license when any alcoholic beverages are to be served. This service is contracted separately from the catering part of your contract and will be billed to you by the company.

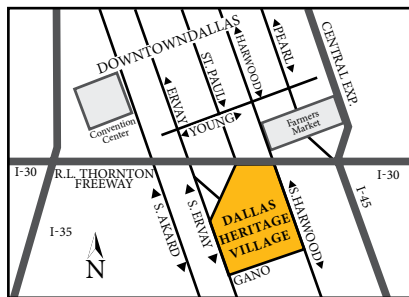
