CURRENT EAGLE SCOUT PROJECTS NEEDED

- Build one new golf cart storage shed.
- Build new zigzag split rail fence around visitor parking.
- Build new picket fence and gate around 1860s Farmstead chicken yard.
- Build fence around Fisher Road House.
- Build fence around donkey paddock.
- Enclose hay storage area behind Carriage House.
- Erect 45 feet of six-foot tall wood fence, plus six-foot gate, to create enclosure for storage of museum construction materials.
